

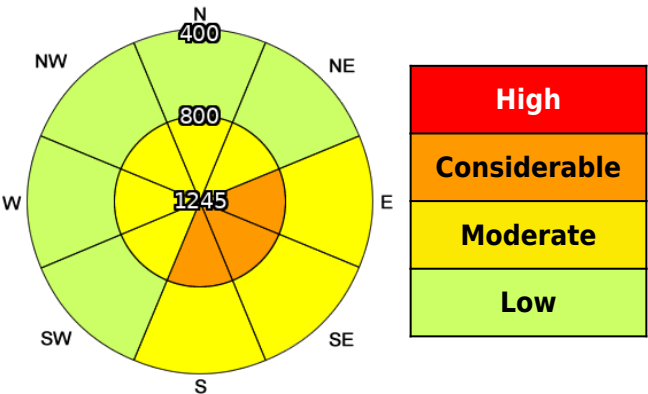
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of weakly bonded windslab will continue to develop and avalanches are likely mainly on Easterly to Southerly aspects above 800 metres. Localised instabilities will affect other aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected on moderate North-West winds. The freezing level will rise from sea level to 300 metres during the day.

Comments

Poor visibility on hill today. Corniced edges difficult to locate in flat light conditions.
