

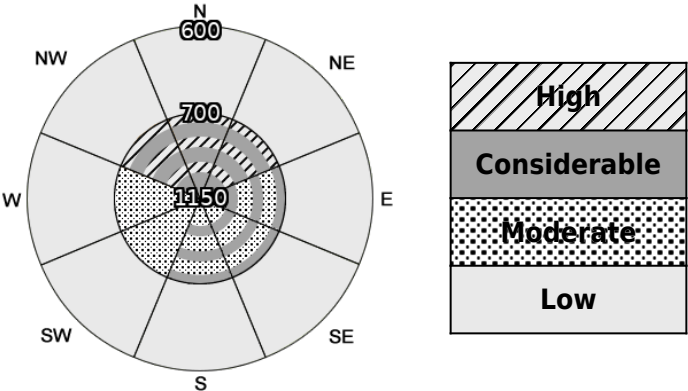

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 19/12/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Avalanches will occur on steep terrain mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 700 metres, due to rapidly building snow accumulations, snowpack instability and rising temperatures. Localised instabilities will form on many other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be heavy snowfall with a rising freezing level to 900 metres, and strong Southerly winds. A brief cycle of thaw will be followed by a lowering freezing level.

Comments

Major change coming in next 24 hours with freezing level rising, heavy snow forecast and change in wind direction.
