

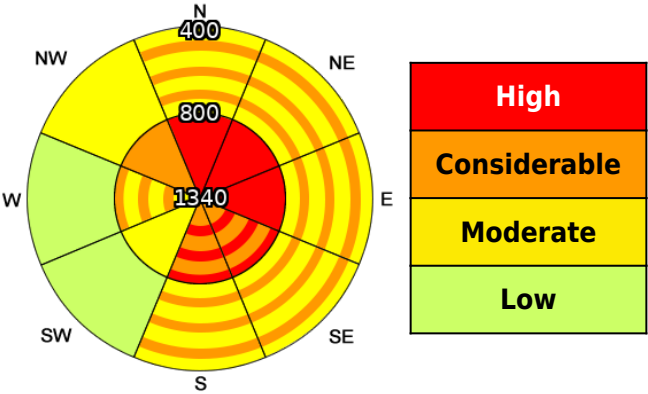

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Extensive areas of unstable windslab are expected above 800 metres on North through East to South aspects where avalanches will occur. Due to cross loading and veering winds, unstable windslab will be deposited on many other aspects. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snowfall is expected overnight and through the day. Southerly winds overnight will veer to the North-West and strengthen through the day. The freezing level will rise to around 800 metres.
