

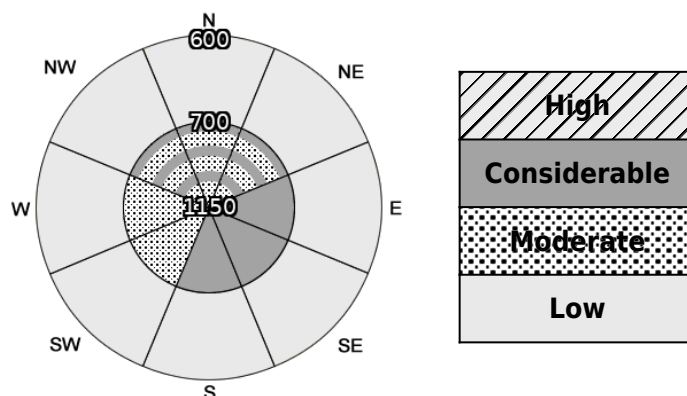

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The change in wind direction will see another re-distribution of snow. Instabilities will be more localised on Northerly aspects above 700 metres. On Easterly to Southerly aspects above 700 metres the instability associated with the near surface crust will be more widespread where avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow will ease off giving a bright dry day, freezing level will be around the 500 metre elevation with strong North-Westerly winds.
