

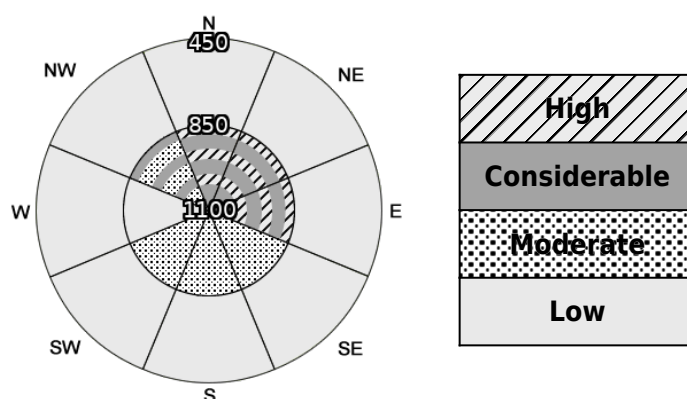

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some further quantities of fresh windslab will develop overnight on steepest North-West through North to East aspects above 850m. A period of high instability will then ensue with the onset of mild conditions and heavy rain. Wet snow avalanches will occur in these locations. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Sleet and snow overnight will be followed by a series of warm fronts which will see freezing levels rising to 2600 metres and milder conditions with heavy rain to all levels. Winds will initially be Southerly, then strengthening West- South- West with the arrival of warm fronts.
