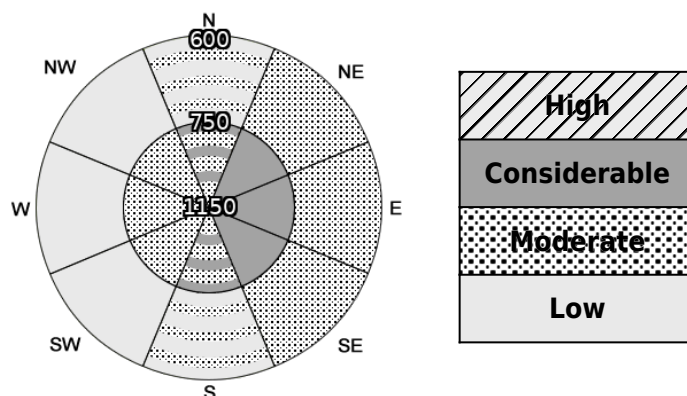


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 22/12/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Generally the snowpack is stabilising. However as the snowpack becomes more saturated instabilities will develop further especially on steep ground on mainly North-East through East to South-East aspects above 750 metres. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Moderate rain, strong West-South-West winds and a freezing level of 3000 metres is expected overnight. In the day, summit temperatures will be around plus 5 degrees and there will be light rain.
