

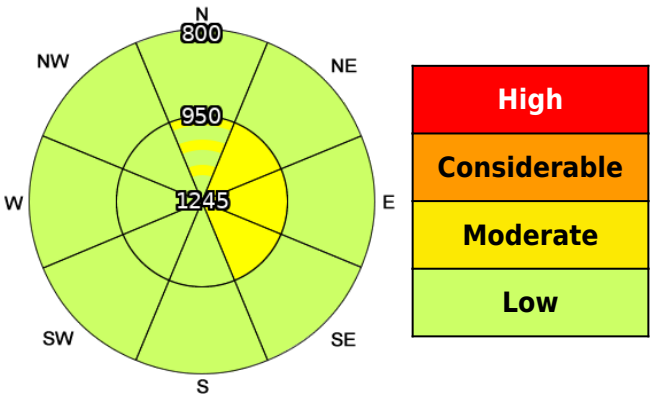

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snowpack will gradually refreeze at all levels and the snowpack will generally become more well bonded and stable. Some fresh accumulations of moderately well bonded snow will form in isolated and sheltered, mainly North-East to South-East locations above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, light rain will turn to snow with snow showers expected during the day. Overnight winds will be strong West-South-Westerly with a freezing level above the summits. The freezing level will lower to 500 metres in the early part of the day. Winds will be strong West-North-Westerly

Comments

Cooler conditions will arrest the thaw.
