

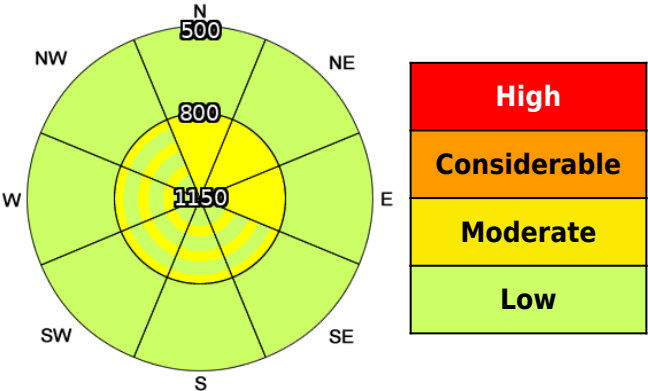

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability will improve as colder conditions effect the area. New accumulations of windslab will form in sheltered locations on North to East aspects mainly above 800 metres. The new deposits will be moderately bonded but not expected to be significant in depth. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight rain at all levels turning to snow above 400 metres. A few snow showers can be expected during the day, winds strong Westerly. Freezing level lowering to 500 metres.
