

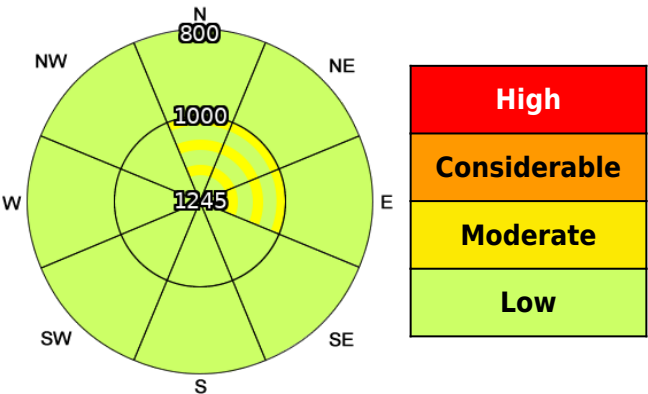

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack that exists in localised areas on North to Easterly aspects will refreeze and consolidate further and will generally be well bonded and stable. Some isolated accumulations of moderately bonded new snow will form in sheltered pockets on mainly North to North-East aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight with light snowfall developing in the day as the freezing level lowers to 700 metres, later, as the freezing level rises to 1200 metres this will turn to rain with sleet on the tops. Wind moderate Westerly during the night, becoming strong South to South-Westerly in the day.
