

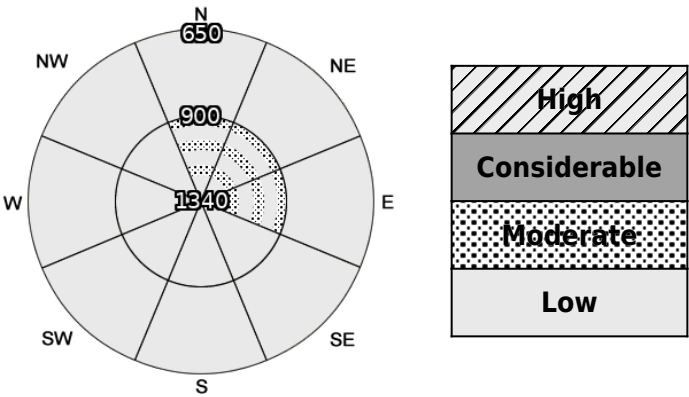

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 27/12/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing wet snowpack will start to refreeze and stabilise. Localised accumulations of fresh snow will be present mainly on North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. New snow accumulations are not expected to be significant. Warmer temperatures later in the day will begin to thaw these new accumulations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Cold and dry conditions overnight. During the day, temperatures will rise slowly and there will be light snow showers. Increasing South-South-West winds
