

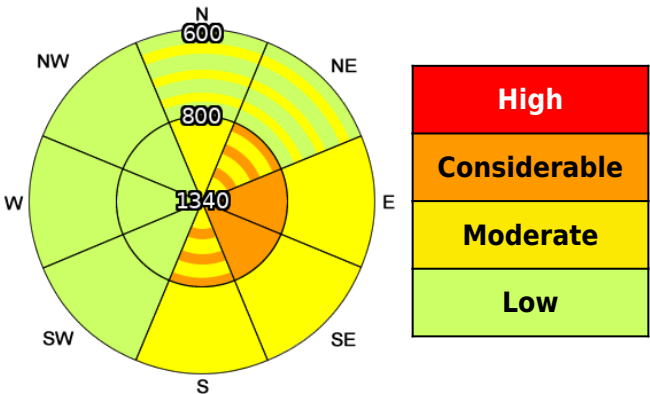

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 29/12/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack, which tends to be quite damp, will freeze and consolidate in the colder conditions. Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited on mainly East to South aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects may also be affect by cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Colder conditions are expected through the period. The freezing level will be around 600 metres, and there will be frequent snow showers. Strong winds will be from the North-West.
