

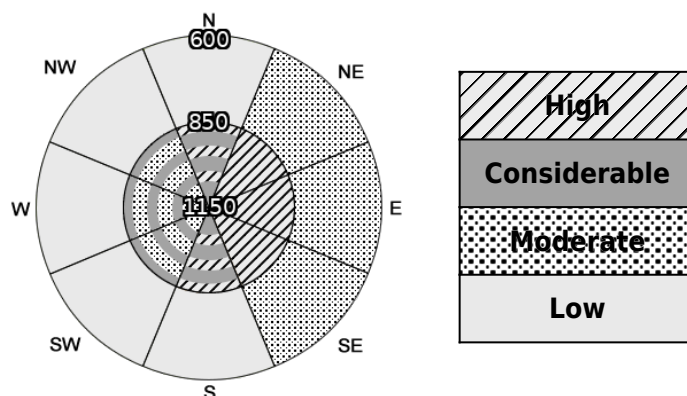

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 31/12/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become saturated and instabilities will worsen. Avalanches will occur mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 850 metres especially during the temperature rise period. On other aspects instabilities will exist especially in the highest locations such as gully tops and corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing levels will rapidly rise to 2200 metres with strong South-Westerly winds. Snow initially will turn to rain, showery in the day.
