

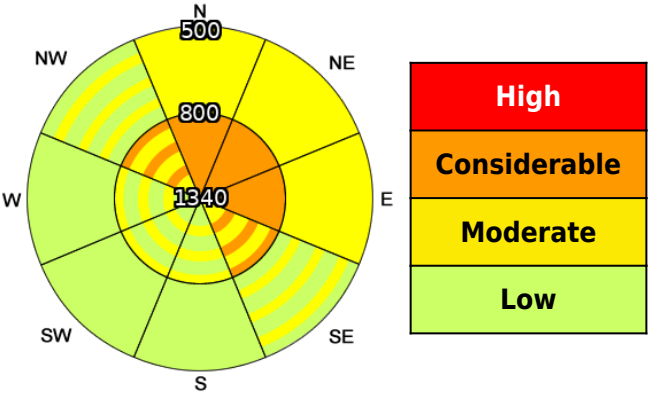

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 01/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will start to refreeze and consolidate. Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies and slopes, especially on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects will be affected by cross-loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Precipitation is expected to change from rain to snow showers overnight as the freezing level lowers to 1000 metres. During the day the freezing level is expected to continue to lower and showers will fall as snow above 500 metres. Winds will be very strong South-Westerly throughout the forecast period.
