

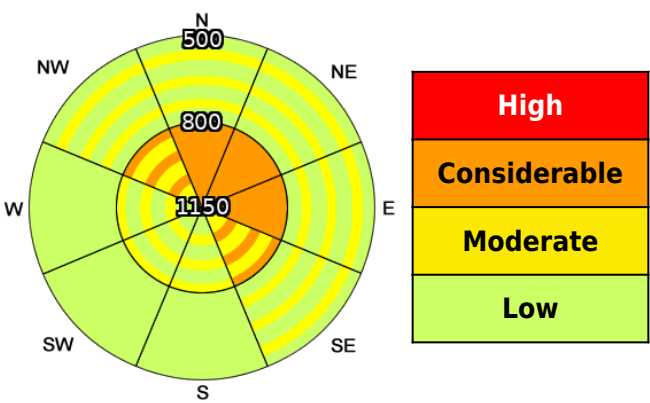

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 02/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

More accumulations of unstable weakly bonded windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. The greatest deposits of instabilities will be in sheltered gullies and on slopes with a North to East aspect mainly above 800 metres. Other aspects will have localised instabilities due to cross loading particularly gullies exits and scarp slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Above 400 metres frequent snow showers will continue to affect the area with strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be around 450 metres.
