

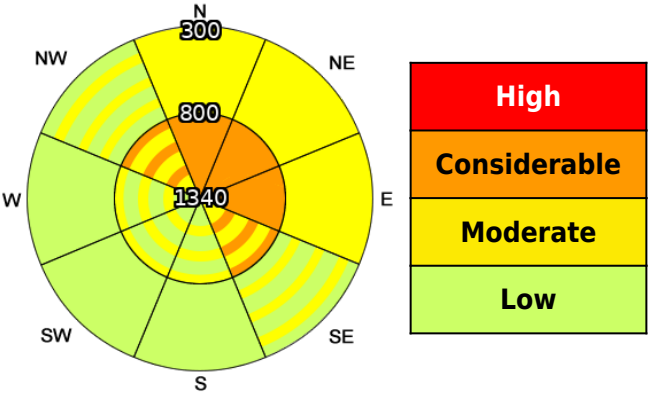

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further accumulations of unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas where avalanches are likely above 800 metres. Greatest accumulations will be in sheltered gullies and on slopes with North to East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects will also be affected by cross-loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected to continue throughout the forecast period, with a freezing level of 450 metres. Winds will be strong South-Westerly.

Comments

Considerable drifting taking place in the strong South-West winds.
