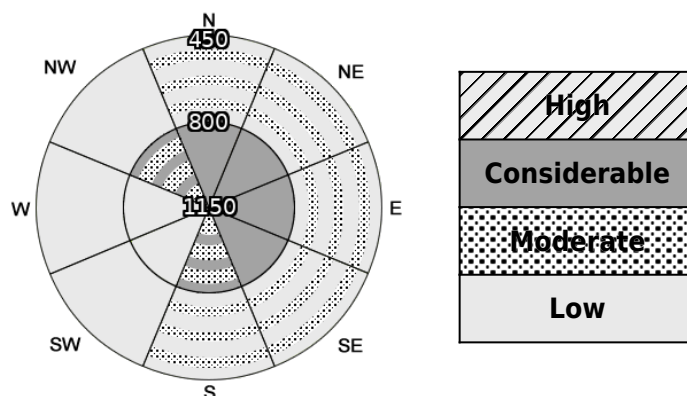


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 03/01/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The drifting snow will continue to accumulate significant deposits of unstable windslab on mainly North to North-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. During the morning further unstable snow will begin to form on East through South-East to Southerly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Heavy snow showers are expected overnight on strong South-Westerly winds which will veer North-Westerly later. By the morning the freezing level will rise for a short time to summit levels, with snow turning to rain.
