

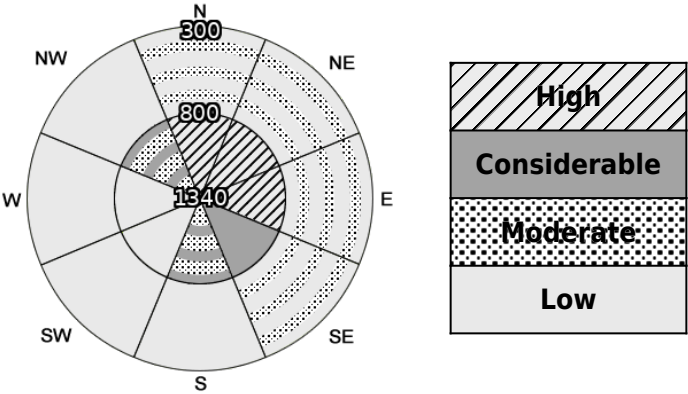

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will become increasingly unstable with the rise in temperature. Further unstable snow accumulations will form overnight on North-West, North and North-East aspects. As the wind turns to the North-West, additional snow loading will occur on East, South-East and South aspects. Avalanches will occur mainly on steep North, North-East and East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy precipitation, rising temperatures and Southerly winds are expected overnight before snow showers, colder temperatures and North-West winds arrive during the morning.
