

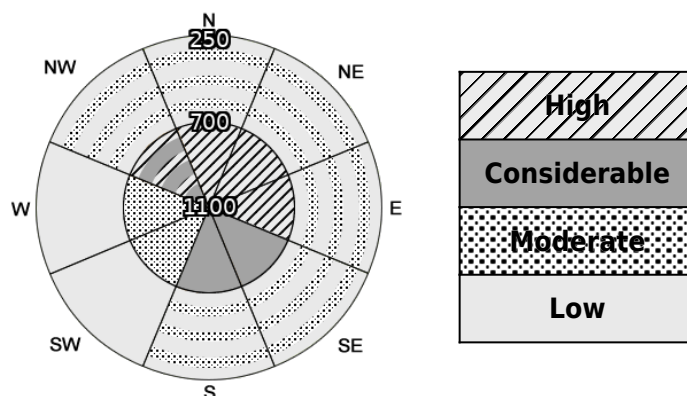

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 03/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of unstable windslab will be present in sheltered gullies and slopes, mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 700 metres, this will weaken further with the rising temperature and here avalanches will occur. In the day, additional fresh, unstable windslab will be deposited on mainly East to South aspects. Other aspects will be affected due to cross-loading. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall is expected overnight with strong South-West then Southerly winds. The freezing level will briefly rise above the summits before dropping to around 600 metres during the day. Then snow showers are expected with strong Southerly veering North-Westerly winds.
