

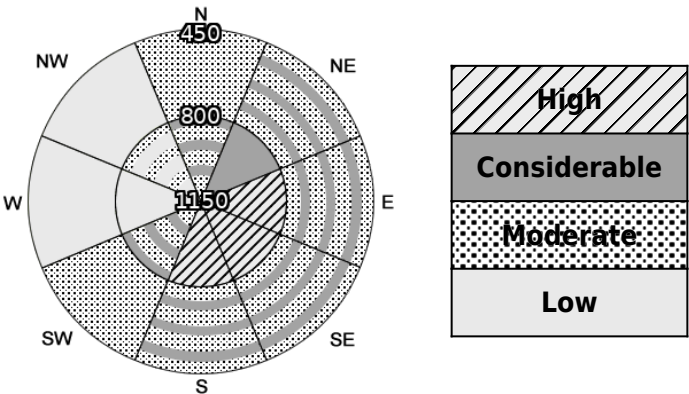

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further accumulations of unstable wind slab will form mainly on East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Many other aspects will also be affected due to cross loading with large accumulations of poorly bonded snow present on steep convex slopes, in gullies and in stream banks in particular. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some prologed moderate snow showers are expected on strong North-Westerly winds throughout the forecast period.. The freezing level will be at 650 metres rising to 1000 metres in the day.

Comments

New snow on all aspects. Up to 10 cms of snow on all aspects expected with severe drifting.
