

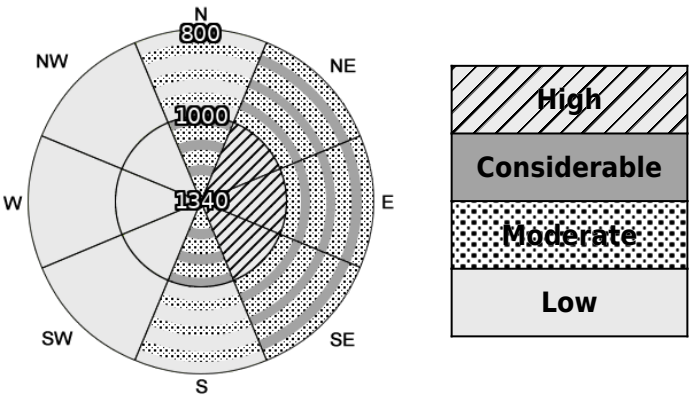

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 05/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 900m, areas of unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations, with greatest accumulations on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects where avalanches will occur. Below 900m, as the freezing level drops, the existing wet snowpack will freeze and become stable. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Showers will continue throughout the period with the freezing level lowering to around 700m during the day. Winds will be from the West or North-West.
