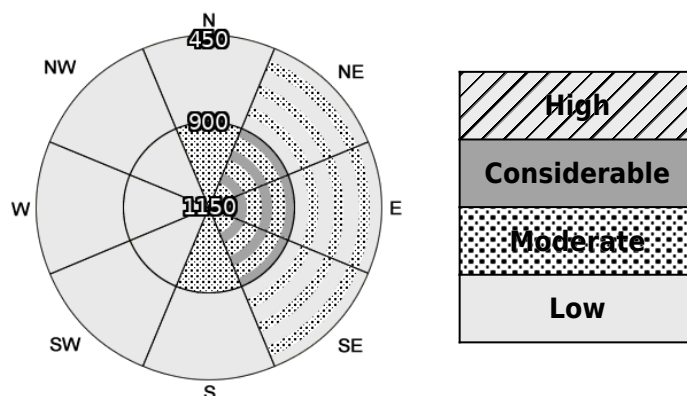


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 06/01/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Significant snow transport will continue with areas of mainly localised unstable slab weakening especially during the temperature rise. Areas most affected will be on high, unsupported convex terrain and around corrie rims of a North-East to South-East aspect above 900 metres where run out potential is greatest. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

No new precipitation is expected. Winds will be from the West backing South-West then veering strong Westerly later tomorrow. Cooling overnight will be followed by warming with the freezing level going up to 1500 metres.
