



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will weaken during the temperature rise and avalanches are likely mostly on steep North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 900 metres. Localised instabilities will also affect other steep locations which have been affected by previous cross loading. Existing cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will rise from 700 to 1500 metres during the day.

Comments

Instabilities will be most prominent during the temperature rise.
