

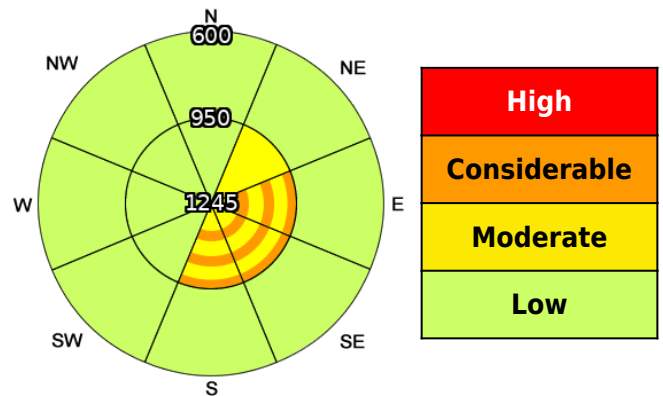

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will generally refreeze and stabilise and will be well bonded throughout. During the day some drifting will form localised pockets of unstable windslab on mainly East to South aspects above 950 metres. Steep gully exits and corrie rims being most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will lower to 600 metres and winds will be dry strong North-Westerly. In the day freezing levels and wind direction will remain the same but the winds will increase in strength with snow showers expected.
