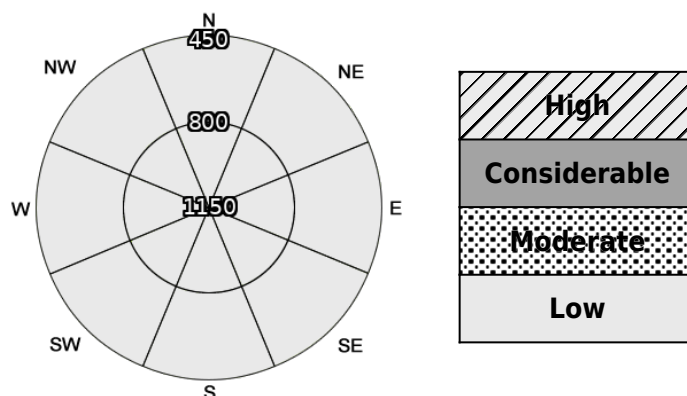

There will be minor snow accumulations on North-East to East aspects above about 750 metres. The existing snowpack above 800 metres will remain stable and well bonded. The rain effect on the existing snowpack above 750 metres will be negligible. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Very light snow showers are forecast overnight with light rain during the day. Winds will be from the West-South-West veering Westerly later. The freezing level will rise to 1500 metres.
