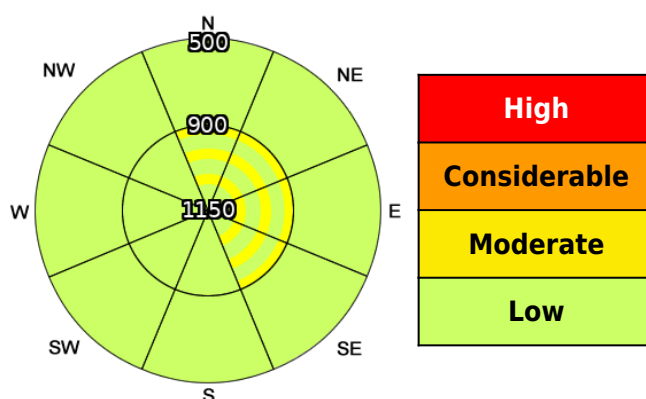


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 10/01/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain generally stable and well bonded on most slopes. However the small amounts of new snow accumulations will become moist and some localised instabilities will exist particularly on steeper slopes with a North through East to South-East aspect mainly above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, some snow at first this will turn to rain fairly early on, the freezing level will rise to around 1800 metres. The winds, strong from the West-South-West.

Comments

The winds could reach 'Gale force' with summit temperatures around plus 3 celsius.
