Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

After an initial period of warming new snow will accumulate on North-East through East to South aspects. This will lead to some instabilities including unstable wind slab which will develop above 750 metres on these same aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

Forecast Weather Influences

Rain showers will turn to snow later in the forecast period. Winds will be strong Westerly veering North-Westerly later. The freezing level will initially be above the summits, lowering to 900 metres overnight then to 600 metres during the day with some snow flurries possible.

Comments

In contrast to yesterday the snow surface is hard, weight supporting and crampons are required.
