

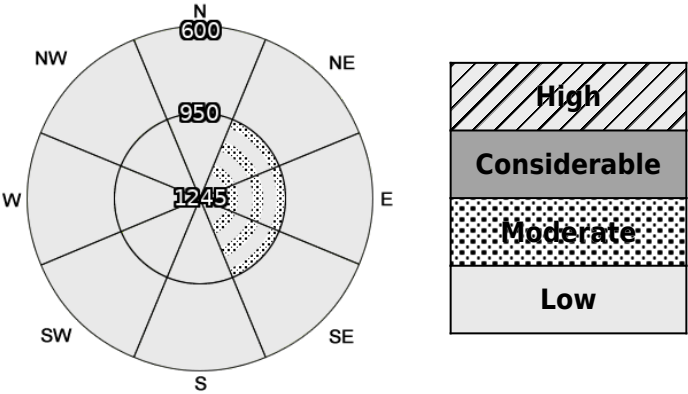

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 13/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack which is lying mostly on North through East to Southerly aspects will remain generally well bonded and stable; However localised, generally avoidable pockets of instability will affect North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres especially around coire rims and gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow will clear and a ridge of high pressure is expected to build leading to dry conditions with light North-West backing Westerly winds. The freezing level will be at around 600 metres.
