

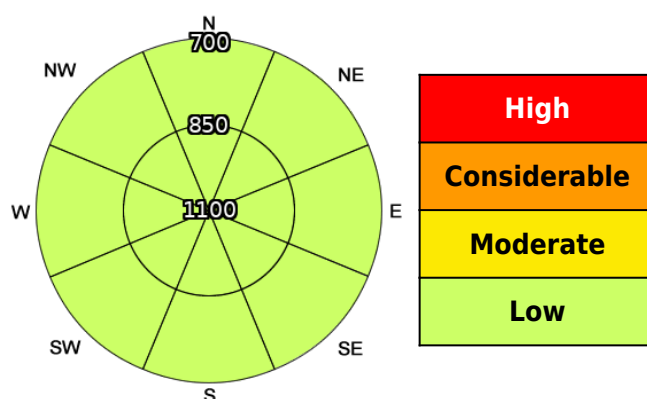

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 17/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well-bonded and stability will be good in all locations. The possibility of some light sleet later in the day with a gradually rising freezing level is unlikely to affect stability over the period. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cold for most of the period before recent high pressure starts to drift away in the afternoon. Midday temperature of minus 2 degrees Celcius on summits with the freezing level rising gradually to 1800m. Winds will increase with unsettled South -Westerly airstream.

Comments

Bit of a change later in the day although conditions will remain icy underfoot for much of the period.
