Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow accumulations will form poorly bonded windslab on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres, especially in the afternoon. Localised unstable deposits will form on other aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable
