

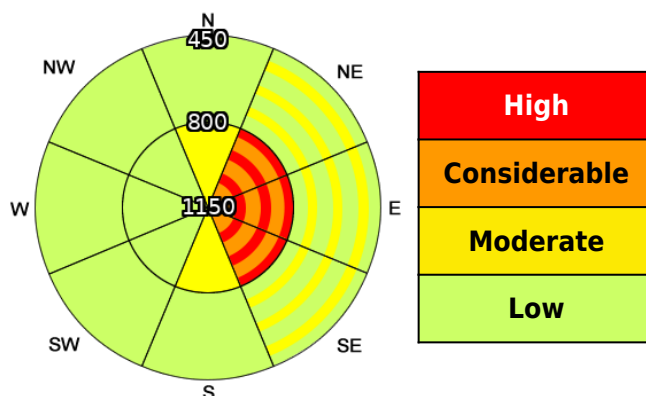

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 20/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be areas on North-East to South-East aspects where avalanches will occur due to new windslab instability. These areas are mainly confined to high angle corrie rims and exit slopes above 800 metres. Continued snow and a warming cycle will further contribute to a period of very poor stability. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will persist this evening, changing to sleet in the morning. The overnight freezing level at 400 metres will rise to 1100 metres for a time, cooling again in the afternoon. Winds will be strong from the North-West backing Westerly later
