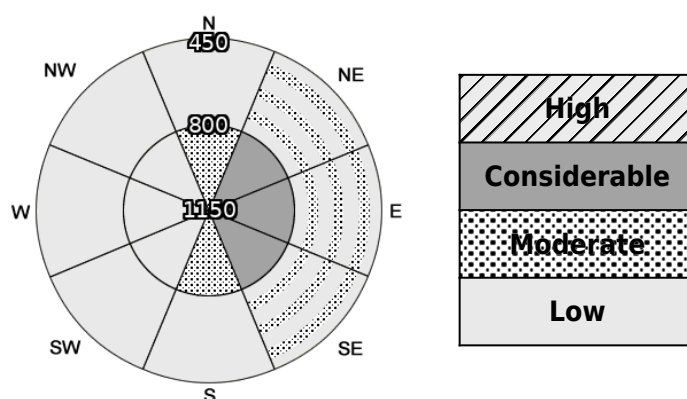

Soft windslab instability will exist on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. The extent of this windslab will increase across and extend to lower levels on high steep corrie rims and exit slopes where avalanches are likely. Recently formed cornices are not strong. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be snow showers and very strong Westerly winds becoming North-Westerly later. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.
