

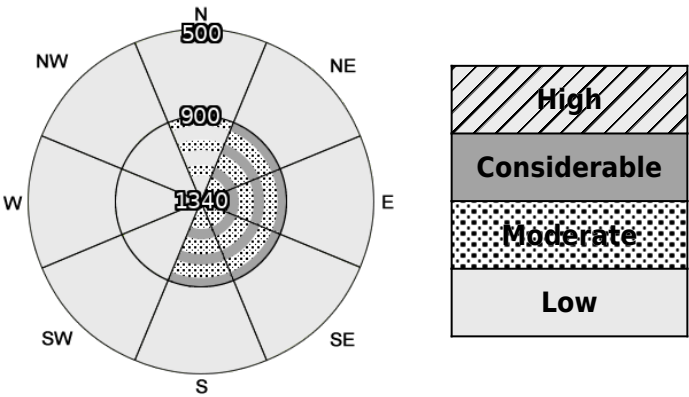

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will continue to form in lee areas. Greatest accumulations will be sheltered gullies, hollows and scarp slopes with a North-East through East to South aspect above 900m. On slopes exposed to the wind, the snowpack will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong North-West winds will continue with snow showers above 600m.
