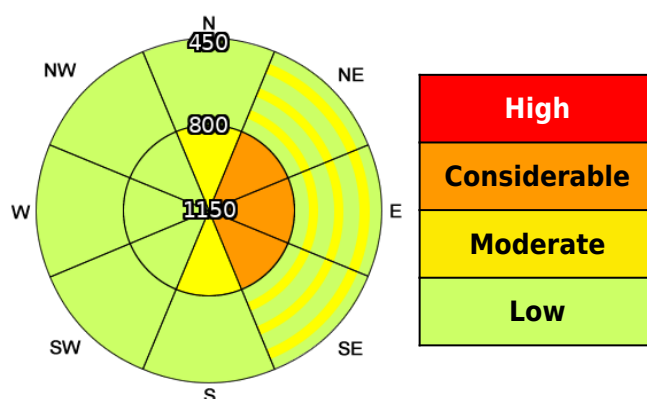


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 22/01/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Drifting of the recent snow will continue and form poorly bonded windslab on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Localised poorly bonded accumulations will form in other isolated hollows and areas due to cross-loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

No precipitation is expected in the forecast period. Overnight the freezing level will be at 600 metres then 700 metres in the day. Winds strong North-Westerly.

Comments

Some high steep convex exit slopes are becoming weaker with the additional snow loading.
