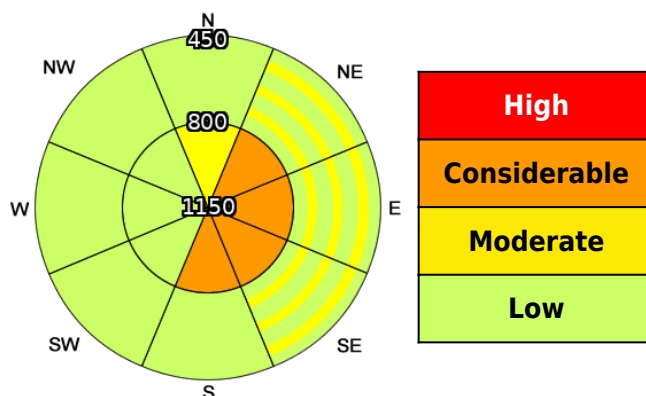

There will be further accumulations of drifted snow on North-East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely due to poorly bonded windslab. Steep, convex terrain corrie rims. This instability will also exist in hollows and cross loaded terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The showery North-West weather pattern will continue for the forecast period. Strong winds from the North-West will ease slightly with freezing level at around 600m.
