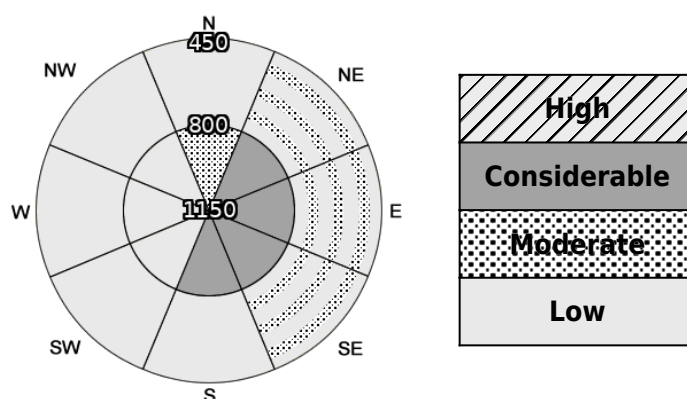


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 24/01/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The thick soft windslab developed over the past few days which is poorly bonded, will be de-stabilised further with the onset of rain. Avalanches are likely on North-East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres, high steep convex terrain, corrie rims and cross loaded areas especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Occasional light snow will turn to rain later in the day. Initially winds will be light from the West, increasing to moderate Southerly veering South-West later. Freezing level will go above the summits.
