

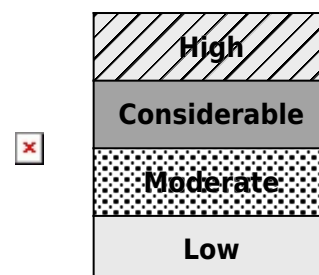
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 25/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of thaw which will affect the snowpack. This will lead to a period of instability when avalanches are likely on North through East to South aspects above 800 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse when the freezing level rises. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Variable freezing levels in the forecast period will be as high as 1600 metres. Winds will be strong South-Westerly backing to very strong Southerly later. There will be periods of occasional rain at all levels.

Comments

After a period of instability due to thaw some stabilization will take place when freezing level drops again.
