

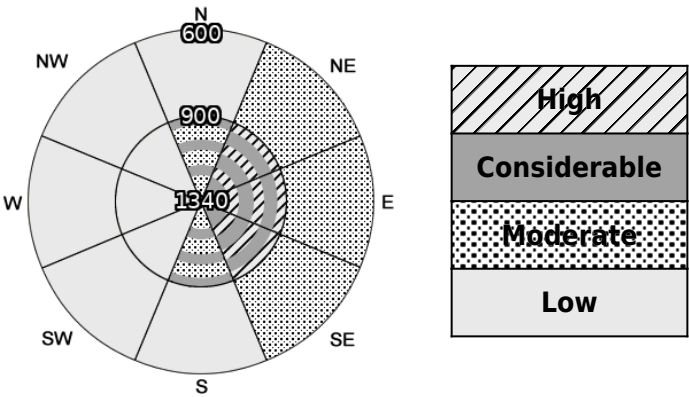

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Avalanches will occur on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres as the significant areas of windslab which exist on these aspects become saturated. The large cornices that are present above these aspects will be prone to collapse. Stability will be much better on Westerly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a wet day, with heavy rain at all levels and strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be above the tops.
