

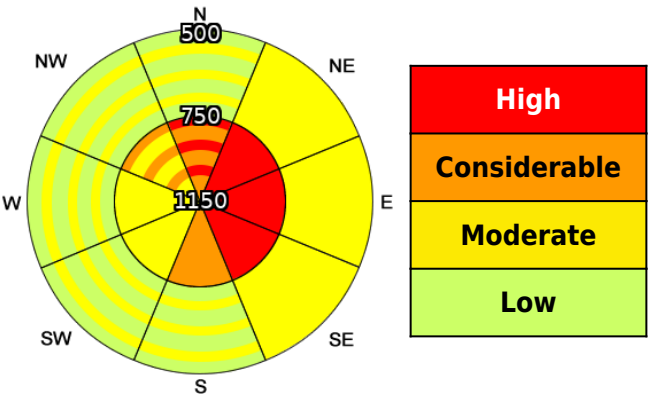

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

On all aspects the snowpack will become increasingly wet. Wet snow instabilities will increasingly develop in the windslab lying mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 750 metres where avalanches will occur. On North-West and South aspects instabilities will be more localised. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day heavy rain is expected at all levels with the freezing level above the summits. Winds will be very strong Southerly during the day.
