

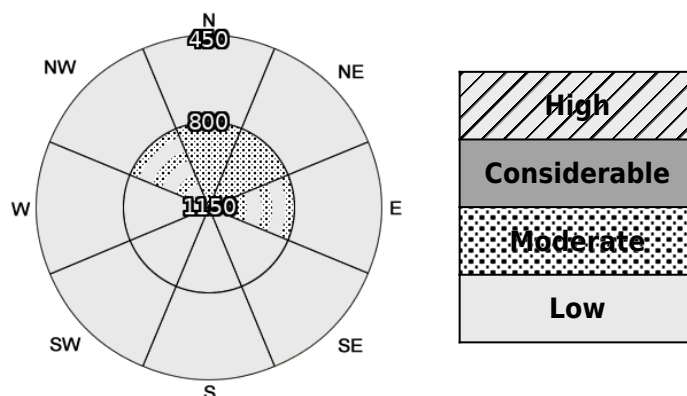

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 26/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Lower temperatures will refreeze the existing snowpack which will become well bonded and stable. Small isolated areas of new windslab will begin to form on North-West to East aspects but these are likely to be avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, moderate rain will turn to snow for a time as the freezing level drops from 1500 metres to 600 metres. During the day there will be light Southerly winds and snow showers. Summit temperatures will be around minus 2 degrees.
