



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 27/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of windslab will remain on North to East aspects above 800 metres. These areas of windslab are not expected to be particularly extensive or deep; However, some instabilities are expected in steep gullies and slopes where any deeper accumulations of windslab lie on top of the old, hard, icy snowpack. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After overnight snow showers, a dry day is expected. Light Westerly winds will veer to the North-West. The freezing level will be around 650 metres.
