

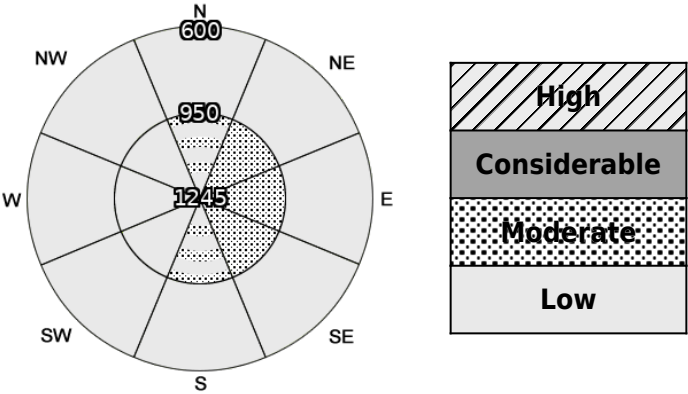

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 28/01/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be little change within the snow pack. Localised instabilities will continue to affect Northerly through East to Southerly aspects above 950 metres mainly around corrie rims and gully tops. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with light North backing South-West winds. The freezing level will rise from 600 to 700 metres during the day.
