

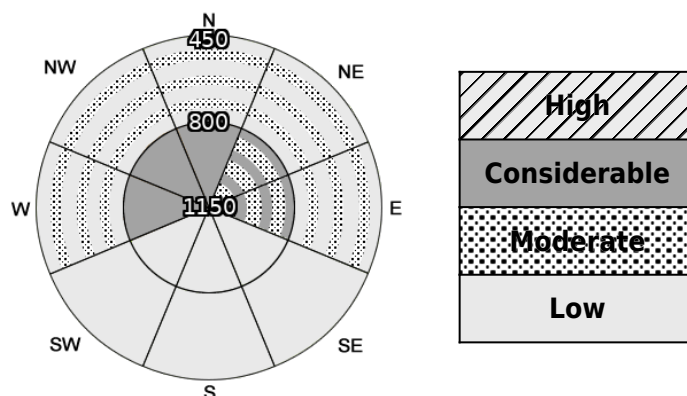

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations will be found mainly above 600 metres with moderately to poorly bonded windslab above around 800 metres on mostly West through North to North-Easterly aspects. Other aspects may be affected due to cross loading. New unstable cornice development will continue. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with some overnight snow falling on strong South-Easterly winds.

Poor visibility this morning but good feedback on conditions from search and rescue teams on the hill.
