

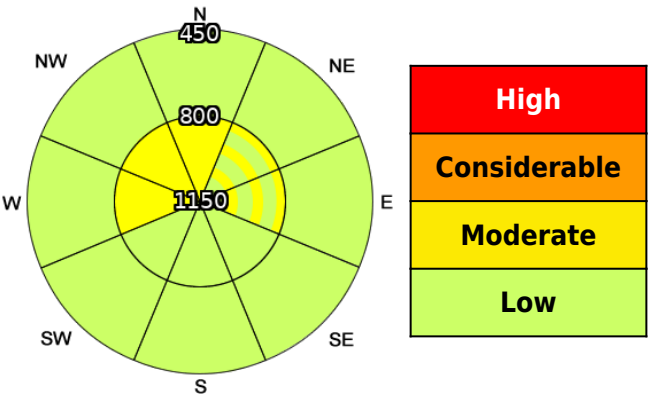

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deeper areas of windslab will be found mostly on West to Northerly aspects and some North-Easterly and Easterly locations above 850 metres. On steeper slopes such as gully exits and scarp slopes accumulations will be moderately to poorly bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will continue cold with no significant new snow. Winds will be moderate from the South-East.

Comments

Wind-chill likely to be high at times during the day.
