

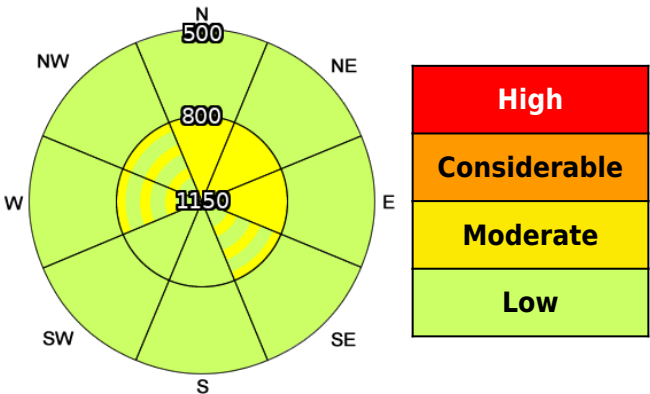

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist in the older windslab present mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Localised recently deposited windslab will be located in sheltered areas on West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres, and the wind may redistribute more snow onto these aspects. The snowpack on wind scoured slopes will generally be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain cold and dry, with strong South-Easterly winds overnight moderating during the day.
