

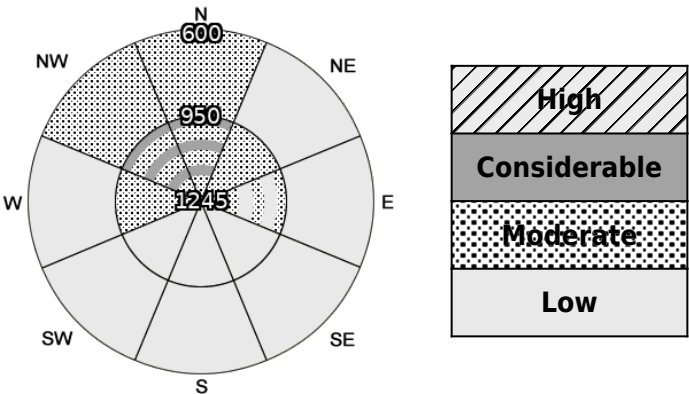

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated areas of weakly bonded windslab will be present on mainly North-West to Northerly aspects above 950 metres, gully exits, crag aprons and corrie rims being especially affected. Elsewhere in wind scoured locations the snowpack is generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry for the forecast period, remaining very cold with overnight Southerly winds becoming West-South-Westerly in the day. Freezing at all levels.

Comments

Good route finding avoiding windslab areas required on some Northerly approaches.
