

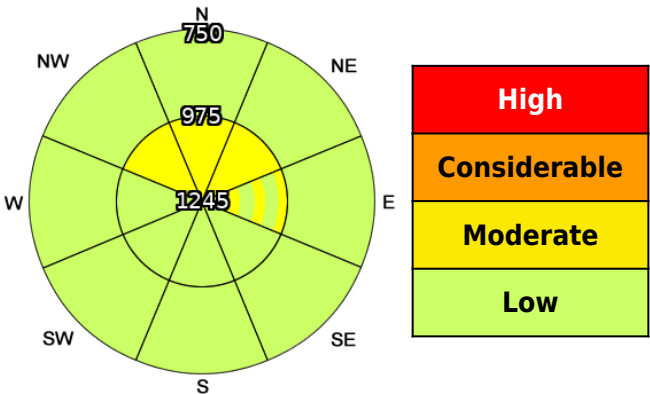

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weaknesses will remain in isolated steep locations on North-West to North-East aspects but will be confined to small hollows, gully exits and corrie rims above 975 metres where the windslab is moderate to poorly bonded. Elsewhere the snowpack is generally stable and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the West winds will become moderate South-Westerly, the freezing level will rise to 300 metres in the day and the winds will remain South-Westerly. It will be dry during the forecast period.
