

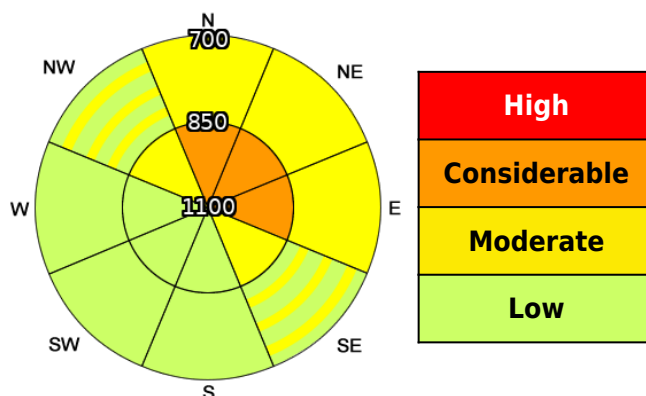

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 04/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting of new snow is expected and stability will deteriorate during the day. Windslab will develop on steep mostly North through North-East to East facing slopes with some cross loading on many sheltered gully flanks. Widespread new snow instabilities will exist in these locations above 850m where avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

An approaching frontal system will bring a change to the settled conditions. Snow showers from early dawn will increase and become more persistent accompanying by strengthen South West winds as the day progresses.
