

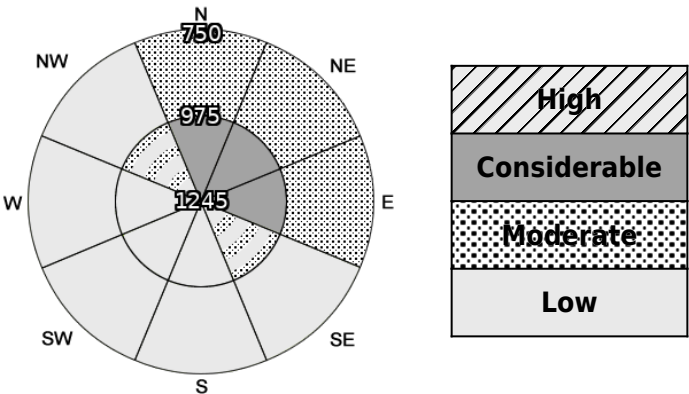
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 04/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant drifting will lead to new windslab accumulations developing. Avalanches are likely on North to East aspects above 975 metres. Corrie rims, gully exits and steep locations will be especially affected. There will also be localised instabilities on North-West and South-East aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night will be followed by snow showers during the day on moderate increasing to strong South-West winds. The freezing level will rise from 300 to 750 metres.
