

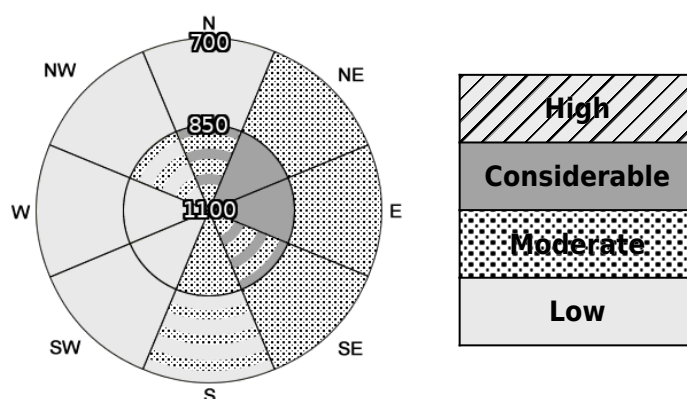
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 06/02/2012

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In areas of steep terrain snow pack instabilities will remain above 850 metres on North to East aspects where avalanches are likely. Gully flanks will also be affected. Cornices will be unstable. Generally below 850 metres the snowpack is moderately well bonded on these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be light North-Westerly with a freezing level of 900 metres lowering to 700 metres. No precipitation is expected.
