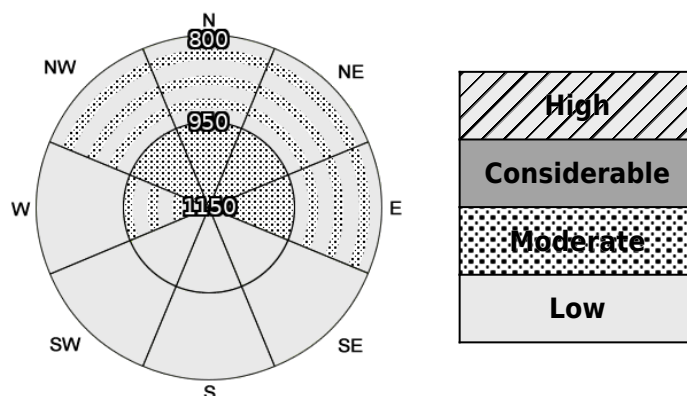


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 07/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Above 850 metres some steeper sheltered locations on North-West through North to East aspects will contain moderately well bonded deposits. Deepest accumulations will be found in gully exits, on scarp slopes and in similar features. Recently formed cornices will be present in the same locations. Elsewhere the snow will be generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry with light becoming moderate Southerly winds. The freezing level will lower to 600 metres overnight and during the day, although milder conditions will start to approach towards the end of the period.

Comments

Summit temperature rising to +1 degree C at 1000m later in period on Tuesday.
